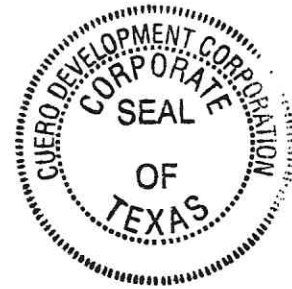

The Board was in agreement that they were not willing to discontinue their services, but would reduce their expenditures for the time being.


