II. OPEN PUBLIC HEARING AND HEAR PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED EXPENDITURES OF TYPE B SALES TAX FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF CUERO PARKS DEPARTMENT

David Danish, City of Cuero Parks Department Superintendent gave a brief explanation of the proposed project. There was a total of \$50,000 earmarked to the City of Cuero Parks Department in the CDC budget. Mr. Danish is requesting that \$38,000 be used to complete the renovation of the walking trail in the Municipal Park. The addition to the walking trail will end at the rodeo arena and the island at the lake will also be included for this project. The excess \$12,000 will be utilized towards an irrigation project for the CYFL football field at Daule Park.

Mr. Joe Humphreys, Executive Director of the UHV-SBDC attended the Cuero Development Corporation due to discussions at the previous Board meeting. It was suggested that Mr. Humphreys give a break-down of the business plan letter that is presented to the CDC Board on behalf of each client. Mr. Humphreys thanked the CDC Board for allowing the SBDC to have an office in their building.

Mr. Humphreys stated that the Business Plan is designed for the business applicant to draw their ideas down and to envision the future of their business. If the business is an existing business, the business plans aren't as extensive as a new business because those individuals have shown responsibility of their assets and don't usually need as much training. Mr. Humphreys and staff draw up the plans and the applicant must follow the modules and have a thorough understanding of their business flow. Mr. Humphreys assured the Board that new applicants must have their ducks in a row in order to receive their business plan recommendation letter. The SBDC services the 10 surrounding counties of Victoria and hope to utilize the Cuero office a two to three days a week.
