#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Mrs. Cromeens commended and presented a plaque to Mr. David Scott for his eight years of dedicated service to the Cuero Development Corporation Board (CDC). Mr. Scott has been an integral part of the CDC Board with his enthusiasm and support of the growth of the community.

#### III. MONTHLY FINANCIALS

Mrs. Cromeens reported that she has met with the City of Cuero Finance Department and they are in the process of completing their budget books for the upcoming fiscal year. Due to a delay in getting a signature on the grant, June's Pearl's is entering her eighth month of business in Cuero. It was mentioned that this business relocated from Goliad and has been successful with their transition to Cuero.

### VI. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

1) Sales Tax Comparisons – A copy of the sales tax revenue report was included in the Board package. It was reported that the sales tax remittance has decreased by 21.24% for the calendar year and has decreased by 16.90% for the fiscal year.

Mrs. Cromeens noted that this time last year there was a lump sum payment from an oilfield company and it has had a major influence on the negative receipts that the City has received to date.

- 2) Discuss upcoming conferences/meetings Mrs. Cromeens will attend the TEDC Annual Conference from October 22<sup>nd</sup> 25<sup>th</sup> in Addison. Mrs. Bayfus will attend the State Fair of Texas in Dallas from October 14<sup>th</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> with Angie Cuellar, Cuero Chamber of Commerce Executive Director. Staff attended a Zoom training with EDOiQ on how to input information into the software database. Staff will attend the Texas Comptroller of Public Account & City of Corpus Christi Regional Economic Development Symposium in Corpus Christi on October 1<sup>st</sup> and the Texas Municipal League's Economic Development Conference in Bastrop from November 14<sup>th</sup> 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) December Events Committee Mrs. Cromeens reported that the December Events Committee has disbanded and staff is diligently working on planning for the fast approaching new season.
- 4) Current Projects A copy of the current projects was included in the agenda packet. A separate attachment included the new Business Start-Up + Program.

The following reports were made regarding the current projects:

- The City of Cuero has complete their work at the Jailbreak Bar & Grill and the CDC is awaiting paperwork for reimbursement of funds.
- Cuero Creamery (The EVthing) complete both of their projects and staff has requested documentation for reimbursement on multiple occasions with no response.
- Sloane Smith and Cliff Foulds have begun work on their buildings with no anticipation of completion before the
  end of the fiscal year.
- Funding has been given to Tri-City Empowerment Council, Cuero Turkeyfest, Complete Hometown Physical Therapy, and Anne Parks Hedrick within the past month.

Building Brands Marketing is recording a video segment on Monster Burger Bar & Grill on October 21<sup>st</sup> at the CDC office. With the assistance of the CDC Staff, Mr. Saenz was the sole recipient of the Texas Travel Industry Recovery Program Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00. This program was established to provide one-time reimbursement grants for the recovery of Texas businesses in the tourism, travel, and hospitality industries that were negatively impacted due to COVID-19. These one-time grants are to reimburse eligible costs to these qualifying businesses.
